**Purpose of the Kentucky Elite Replacement Does Sale:** The purpose of Kentucky Elite Replacement Doe Sale is to provide Kentucky goat producers with an opportunity to sell their replacement does in an environment that will highlight local attributes of homegrown quality Kentucky goats. Secondly, this sale will provide an ideal buying opportunity for new and experienced producers needing to add healthy

farm fresh does to their breeding herds. These does will quickly adapt to the home environment and become a productive addition to the breeding herd.

**Important Dates:** Candidate does will be inspected Monday, March 22 – Friday March 26. In addition, Friday, March 12 (Post Mark Date) will be the last day to consign a doe for the 2010, Kentucky Elite Replacement Doe Sale.

**Making Application:** All applications must be post marked on or before Friday, March 12, 2010. Mail this form to the Marion County Extension Office, 415 Fairground Road, Lebanon, KY 40033.

The registration fee (\$15.00) must be paid by check on the day of inspection after and passing inspection. The registration fee is payable to the Kentucky Elite Replacement Doe Sale in the amount of \$15.00 per consigned doe. No additional fee will be required for doe's with nursing kids.

### **Sale General Guidelines**

**Sire General Requirements:** All sires of candidate does can be register or nonregistered, purebred, full blood or crossbred but must be of known breed origin.

**Doe General Requirements Breed Type and Age:** Consigned and candidate does can be registered or non-registered, crossbred, purebred or full blood all of known breed type. If the doe is bred, sire breed must be known, registration not required. All does consigned must be between 8 month to 4 years of age and must be bred, ready to breed or with nursing kids. Open does over 18 months of age must show signs of kidding.

**Doe Ownership Requirements:** All doe must be from the farm of origin or owned by the consigner for a minimum of 60 days prior to the sale. All bred does must be owned by the consigner at the time of breeding. Sales recites

and other forms of purchased date verification are required the day of consignment.

**Limit to Number of Does Consigned:** Each producer has a consignment limit of 10 head. However, the Sales Committee plans to offer 100 inspected and consigned does for sale. If additional does are needed, the Sales Committee may agree to increase the number of does that can be consigned by a single producer in order to assure a total field of 100 head.

**On-Farm Certification/Ear Tag Identification:** All does will be ear tagged following an on farm inspection and approval of candidate doe(s) by members of the Inspection Committee. Each doe will be identifying with a unique tag and will be the official tag of the Kentucky Elite Replacement Doe Sale. A second inspection will be conducted at the delivery date and in conjunction with ultra-sound pregnancy examination.

In a case where a candidate doe is not approved either on farm or at the sales site, a substitute doe that can pass the certification process may be substituted. In any case, there will be no reimbursement of the consignor fee(s) if a consignor fails to bring a consigned doe or a portion of a number of consigned does.

Inspection criteria includes verification of age, body weight, body condition, udder fitness and a general inspection of hair, eyes, mouth, teeth, feet and legs, as well as muscling and visual conformation. Does showing signs of Caseous Lymphadenitis (CL), sore mouth, foot rot/scald and other apparent signs of disease will not be admitted to the sale.

- **Decision of the inspection committee is final.**

**Statement of Vaccination and Treatment:** Each consignor must submit a vaccination and internal/external parasite treatment statement. (*For details of treatments, see "Requirements for the Kentucky Elite Replacement Doe Sale"*) Clostridial vaccinations, specifically *Clostridium perfringens* types C&D (Enterotoxemia) and *Clostridium tetani* (Tetanus) must be given in the current year but not within 2-weeks of the sale date.

Secondly, internal and external parasite treatments should be given no more than 15 days prior to the sale. The official drug and insecticide treatment statement sheet will be provided by the Sales Committee and

must be signed by the consignor or a Kentucky Board Certified Veterinarian (*Preferred*). This will accompany the doe(s) and must be provided the day of receiving for the sale, Friday, May 21, 2010.

- *Refer to the official sale document, Requirements for Consignment and Sale, for the Kentucky Elite Replacement Doe Sale for specific drug type and dosage recommendations.*

**Health Certificate Requirement:** All consigned does must have an official health certificate, and the document must be dated no earlier than 30 days prior to the sale date of May 22, 2010.

Furthermore, all consigned does must have an official Kentucky Scrapie Tag or a registration tattoo. Registration tattoos must be accompanied by the hard copy registration documentation.

- *Consigned does will not be allowed to unload at the receiving site without a health certificate, Scrapie Tag or registration tattoo. There will be no exceptions to this requirement.*

**Sales Procedure:** All does will be sold individually, as a single animal unless the doe is sold with nursing kids by her side. Each consigning farm will be provided an individual pen therefore all goats from a consigning farm will be penned together (*as long as space allows*).

The consignor is responsible for delivering the doe(s) to the fairground on Friday, May 21 in a timely manner. The consignor is responsible for feeding and watering animals. Water will be provided on site. All consigned does will not be released until all does have been sold.

- *The Kentucky Replacement Does Sales Committee or the Marion County Fair Board will not be responsible for accidental injuries to or disappearance of consigned animals. However security will be provide on the day/night of receiving and the day of the sale.*

**Viewing of Animals:** All consigned does will be open for public viewing from 9:00 A.M.-12:00 noon on the morning of the day of the sale. The sales committee strongly encourages each consignor to stand and represent their respective animals at viewing. This is an ideal time to point out doe attributes and to field potential buyer questions.

**Check-in Time Assignment:** All consigned does will be checked into the sale the day before the sale on Friday, May 21, 2010. Due to our comprehensive check-in protocol which includes the second health screening, review of the health and registration papers, pregnancy check by ultra-sound, each consignor will be given a specific check-in time. Consignors missing a check-in time will be placed into the next available unscheduled open time slot.

Adherences to the check-in time will prevent congestion, reduce overall check-in time and most importantly decrease the time livestock are confined on trailers.

- *The Sales Committee reserves the right to reject any animal on the day of the sale following a second health screening at check-in.*

**Ultra-Sound Verification Bred or Open:** All consigned does will be verified either bred and pregnant or not bred and open through ultra-sound verification.

- *Does that are less than 30 days pregnant will not be detected by ultra-sound and the doe will be designated as an open doe. The results of the pregnancy verifications will be announced from the auctioneers stand as the animal enters the sales arena.*
